Another Top-10 Finish for Yontz

Alex Yontz earns fifth Top-10 finish of the season



Lexington, NC — Alex Yontz and the #77 C & J Energy Services team participated in the UARA-STARS race at Lonesome Pine Raceway on Saturday night. The event presented by Freedom Ford was the seventh UARA race of the season. While the car count was low, the competition remained fierce.

Yontz was sixth fastest in the final practice Saturday. He earned a tenth place starting position for the 150-lap event.

Seconds into the race, George Miedecke turned over the lead to Brennan Poole who stayed there to the finish. There were only two cautions throughout the event. In the closing laps of the race Candace Muzny of the No. 92 car was racing side-by-side with Yontz. However, Yontz was able to pull away to finish in seventh place, Muzny resigned to eighth place.

Yontz moved up to fifth in the UARA Driver Standings. He is entered in the next UARA event at Tri-County Motor Speedway on July 29.

Yontz will race tonight in the Dagget Shuler Attorneys At Law Rusty Harpe Memorial 350 at Caraway Speedway. Drivers qualified for the 250-lap NASCAR All-American Whelen Series race last night. Yontz had the fastest qualifying lap time of 16.924. The second fastest lap was 16.984, driven by Caraway Speedway local, Dan Moore. The grandstands open at 5 PM this evening and the races start at 7 PM.
