Cardinal Motorsports Returns to Hickory

The #77 of Alex Yontz Takes Eighth Place



Lexington, NC — Alex Yontz and the #77 C&J Energy Services team rolled into Hickory Motor Speedway Friday afternoon to set up for a short practice session before the UARA-STARS race on Saturday.

The UARA series season opener was at Hickory in early March. The teams returned Saturday for the third annual Banjo Matthews Memorial 150.

Yontz was ninth in the first practice Saturday morning and qualified 17th for the 150-lap race.

When the green flag waved, Yontz began passing cars. By the halfway point of the race, he was running in seventh place. Yontz worked to keep the car in the top-10 in the final laps and succeeded with an eighth place finish. Kyle Grissom of the #31 car took first place.

The Cardinal Motorsports team will race this Saturday at Lonesome Pine Raceway in Coeburn, Virginia. This race will be the seventh race of the UARA-STARS season. Yontz will also race in the NASCAR All-American Whelen race at Caraway Speedway on July 6.
