## **Alex Yontz moves up to Fourth in Driver Points**

*After finishing third at Kingsport Speedway Yontz moves up in UARA driver points*



**Lexington, NC** — Cardinal Motorsports took the No. 77 C&J Energy Services Chevrolet to Kingsport this past weekend for the UARA-STARS race. Driver, Alex Yontz earned a third place finish and moved up to fourth in the driver point standings.

The team unloaded the car on Friday and set up for a short practice. Yontz and the crew felt good about the car during practice Friday and Saturday. He earned a sixth place starting position during qualifying Saturday afternoon.

The 18-car field lined up for the start of the Courtesy Chevrolet 150 shortly after 9 PM Saturday night. Brennan Poole in the No. 7 car was on the pole with Lee Tissot in the No. 25 car on the outside pole. As soon as the green flag waved, Yontz began working his way up through the top-five. Tissot pulled ahead of Poole for the lead and with about 40 laps to go, Kyle Grissom and Alex Yontz moved past Poole to fall in behind Tissot. They stayed hot on his heels until the end. Tissot, Grissom, Yontz, Poole and Coleman Pressley completed the top-five.

Yontz earned his best finish of third this season in the UARA-STARS series. This moved him into fourth place in the driver point standings. Yontz also earned the G-Force South Shift of the race award at Kingsport for moving up the most positions.

Cardinal Motorsports will travel to Anderson, SC this Friday for the next UARA-STARS race at Anderson Motor Speedway. The teams will practice on Thursday and race Friday night at 8 PM.
